

## Types of jetty timber for sale

These are the main type of timber. There are some other types in smaller quantities, plus the stringers and piles that have been collected into “lots” and will be sold in bulk due to difficulty moving individual pieces on a pick ‘n’ mix basis.

All new timber was sustainably sourced.

	<p><b>New hardwood stringer offcuts – various sizes</b>            300mm x 180mm x (variable lengths)            H5 durability. Species is grey ironbark or spotted gum.</p> <p>Price: \$150 per metre pro rata. All are less than a metre long (for example, a 33cm-long piece is \$50, a 20cm-long piece is \$30)</p>
	<p><b>Pile offcuts</b>            300mm diameter            Treated (H6) Australian hardwood used in the new piles.            Species: spotted gum or grey ironbark.            Good for landscaping – very durable.            Price:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Slice = \$1 each</li> <li>• Length = \$10 each</li> </ul>
	<p><b>New plank offcuts</b>            190mm x 45mm x (variable lengths)            Coated with clear oil.            Beautiful hardwood, grey ironbark or spotted gum.            Price:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1m or longer = \$50 per metre</li> <li>• Less than 1m = \$30 per metre</li> <li>• Less than 30cm = \$5 per metre</li> <li>• Less than 10cm = \$1 per metre</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Pile offcuts – H6 treated Australian hardwood</b>            700mm high x 300mm diameter            Use for garden features – stools, tables, chopping blocks, retaining wall            Price: \$40 each</p>

	<p><b>New H6 treated pine rounds</b>  Small than piles, these were used for cross-bracing.  Price:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 90mm x 90mm = \$1 each</li> <li>• 180mm diameter = \$10 each</li> <li>• 150mm diameter = \$5 each</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Australian hardwood - new</b>  100mm x 300mm x (variable lengths – 350mm to 940mm, mostly 530mm)  These are splice plates used on the new jetty, class 1 durability.  Price = \$100 per metre pro rata</p>
	<p><b>Treated pine planks H3.2</b>  200mm x 45mm x (variable lengths)  From the old jetty. These are mostly 1 to 2 metres long.  So many uses – make a deck, some steps, a seat, a shelf...  Price:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1m or longer = \$5 each</li> <li>• 1m or longer with spikes = \$4 each</li> <li>• Less than 1m = \$1 each</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Treated pine handrails</b>  100mm x 100mm x (various lengths)  Removed from the old jetty.  Great for landscaping – fencing, posts, even pop a bird feeder on top of one.  Price:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1m or longer = \$8 per metre</li> <li>• Less than 1m = \$2 per metre</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Small pieces of treated pine</b>  Bits of planks, handrails, etc from the old jetty.  Cannot be burned because it is treated. Could be used for interesting (or boring) garden projects.  Price: Free</p>

**Eucalyptus globoidea plank offcuts**

190mm x 45mm x (various lengths)

Hardwood harvested from Little River in 2019. Used for planks and handrails on new jetty.

A dense, heavy hardwood. Perfect for landscaping. Makes wonderful firewood too!

**Eucalyptus globoidea handrail offcuts**

100mm x 100mm x (various lengths)

Hardwood harvested from Little River in 2019. Used for planks and handrails on new jetty.
